

## Clean Water State Revolving Fund Loan Program ADDENDUM 1 to 2018 Capitalization Grant Intended Use Plan

The State of New Hampshire conducted a second solicitation for pre-applications for the development of asset management programs for wastewater and stormwater systems to ensure that all potential Clean Water State Revolving Fund (CWSRF) loan recipients had an opportunity to participate.

The second solicitation for Asset Management Programs was sent on October 29, 2018 to all potential loan recipients and NH Pre-Qualified Engineers.

A total of five (5) pre-applications were received by the deadline of December 3, 2018. The total value of the pre-applications received was \$259,000, summarized in the Addendum to the 2018 Clean Water State Revolving Fund Project Priority list, below.

All projects will be eligible to receive additional financial assistance in the form of principal forgiveness (up to \$30,000 for each program) if the project results in the development and implementation of an asset management program that meets the State's guidelines for asset management programs.
