Disadvantaged System Criteria

Communities will be classified as disadvantaged if they meet any one of the criteria listed below.

- Water rates for 3,400 gallons average usage are greater than or equal to 1.25% of community Median Household Income (MHI)
- Community with census tracts that have a poverty rate greater than or equal to 20% (Using the Census Bureau's official poverty measure)
- Communities with 3.4% or greater unemployed population (for 16+ civilian labor force)
- Communities with 11.7% or greater of the population receiving food stamps/SNAP benefits
